The Program introduces legal, anthropology and other social science students to career opportunities in the area of native title and Indigenous affairs more generally. Interns provide assistance to under-resourced and over-worked legal and research teams who work at Australia's Native Title Representative Bodies (NTRBs), Prescribed Bodies Corporate (PBCs) and other organisations involved in policy development, social justice and human rights, all with an Indigenous focus.

Internships take place for a 4 to 6 week period over the winter and summer university breaks, with some flexibility for recent graduates.

We are interested in any insights you can provide in relation to the applicant:

- academic success and overall intellectual capacity
- interest in the area of native title, Indigenous affairs and/or social justice generally
- reliability, empathy and ability to work with people in what can be a difficult environment
- maturity, common sense and initiative
